The following Codes of Conduct have been devised by the West Lothian Football Forum and are based on the concept of fair play, defined by:

- 1. Respect for the rules
- 2. Respect for the referees and their decisions
- 3. Respect for all participants, including team-mates, coaches and opponents
- 4. Equal participation (where appropriate)
- 5. Maintaining self-control at all times
